You have decided to participate in parachuting (skydiving) course, so The Finnish Aeronautical Association (FAA) warmly welcomes you to the world of aviation. In this paper, we will introduce our membership benefits, which you will get as a member of FAA.

Magazine

You will receive the ILMAILU magazine delivered to your home address 6 times a year. This magazine will help you to stay current with international aviation events as well as tell you what is happening in Finnish skies. ILMAILU will also broaden your knowledge of aviation in general.

License

After student training (minimum 25 jumps) you can get skydive A-license. License fee is included in FAA member fee. FAA admits about 700 skydive licenses per year.

Third party liability insurance

As a member organization of The Finnish Olympic Committee FAA has made an agreement about third party liability insurance.

The insurance is valid when the skydiver has paid the membership fee of FAA and his/her permanent residence is in Finland. It covers damage to property or to people (third party) caused by a skydiver, if he/she is deemed to be responsible.

The insurance (*Tuplaturva*, insurance number 16-549-997-7) is valid also during competitions and demo jumps in Europe. The maximum indemnity is one million euros and deductible are 600 euros. This insurance is so called secondary insurance. If a skydiver has a home or travel insurance which covers damage it is the primary insurance.

Accident insurance for parachutists

Membership in FAA also includes a **collective accident insurance** (*Sportturva*, insurance number 06-21893). Please note that normal accident insurance does not usually cover parachuting activities. [For more insurance details.](#)

This insurance covers all the recreational aviation branches of FAA and is valid in competition as well. The insurance is valid also abroad (trips under 3 months) in all countries that comply with international aviation regulations.

Indemnities: medical coverage up to 15 000 euros, disability up to 30 000 euros and death up to 8 500 euros and deductible is 200 euros. There are no age limits, but your permanent residence must be in Finland.



HOW TO JOIN THE FINNISH AERONAUTICAL ASSOCIATION (FAA)

Joining FAA happens differently in different clubs. Ask your instructor whether you will automatically be made a member of FAA before your first jump (this is not necessarily the case). If not, please go to our website and fill the form: liity.ilmailuliitto.fi

Membership fees for new members in 2026

The amount of membership fee depends on the joining time. The reduction in membership fees is possible only when joining FAA for the first time.
